CAMP GARRETT DISCIPLINE PLAN

Camp Garrett has adopted the following discipline plan for all campers. We approach discipline in a serious, yet positive manner. Desirable behavior will be rewarded with positive reinforcement. In the event that the child exhibits inappropriate or negative behavior, the staff shall talk to the child, and enlist his/her help in solving the immediate problem. The following discipline procedures will be discussed with your child on the first day of camp and will be posted for future reference. PARENTS please make sure that you discuss the discipline policy with your child.

CAMP GARRETT DISCIPLINE POLICY

MINOR VIOLATIONS: Those violations that relate to behavior and do not endanger the safety of themselves or others.

Examples: Using profanity, teasing, not obeying counselors, insubordination, bullying.

- 1st Offense- Verbal warning
- 2nd Offense- Removal from current activity
- 3rd Offense- Sent to office, call to guardians from Camp Director
- 4th Offense- Sent to office, call to guardians, 1 day suspension

*Minor violations accumulate throughout the summer.

MAJOR VIOLATIONS: Those violations that endanger the safety or well being of the child, other children, or staff.

Examples: Pushing, shoving, hitting, throwing objects (toys, rocks, sticks, food) at/around others, theft, running off, and bullying.

- 1st Offense- Sent to office, Call to parents from Camp Director
- 2nd Offense- Parents called to come pick up the child, suspension from program for 1 day. Meet with parents to discuss options.
- 3rd Offense- Child removed from the program (Expulsion)

*Major violations accumulate throughout the summer & carry over to the next session(s).

IMMEDIATE DISMISSAL: Some violations will require immediate dismissal. They will be up to the discretion of the Camp Director. Guardians will be notified immediately.

CAMP GARRETT CODE OF CONDUCT

Those participating in or attending activities, programs, or events at Camp Garrett are required to conduct themselves according to the participant code of conduct. This code operates in conjunction with the Garrett-Williamson Foundation participant behavioral expectations and policies.

The following are not permitted at activities, programs, or events:

- Possession, consumption, or distribution of alcohol
- Possession, use, or distribution of illegal drugs
- Possession or use of all tobacco products
- Sexual activity
- Theft, destruction, or abuse of property
- Unauthorized absence from a program site
- Physical, emotional, mental, or verbal abuse of another individual
- Possession or use of any harmful object with intent to hurt or intimidate others
- Fighting
- Failure to comply with blatant disregard of directions from a supervising adult or counselor
- Foul language
- Other conduct deemed inappropriate by supervising adults

If the code is violated, the following steps will be taken:

- The parent will be notified and arrangements made for transportation home at the parents expense
- The participant will be barred from participating in future events
- If any laws are violated, the case will be referred to the police

My parent/guardian and I have read and discussed the Participant Code of Conduct as well as the Camp Garrett Discipline Policy. I am aware that my actions affect me and others and may result in the loss of privileges during the event and for future events. We agree that I will conduct myself in accordance with the intent of the behavioral expectations and the code. I will accept the appropriate and logical consequences of my actions if I fail to do so.

Furthermore, if it is determined by the supervising adults in charge that my behavior severely violated the code, I understand that a call will be placed to my parents/guardians and they may be required to arrange transportation at their expense.
